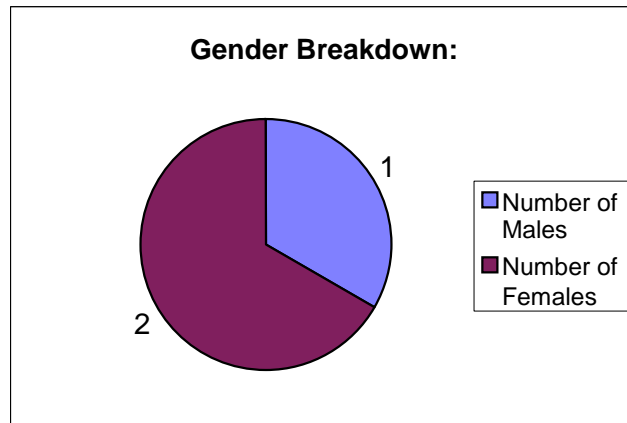

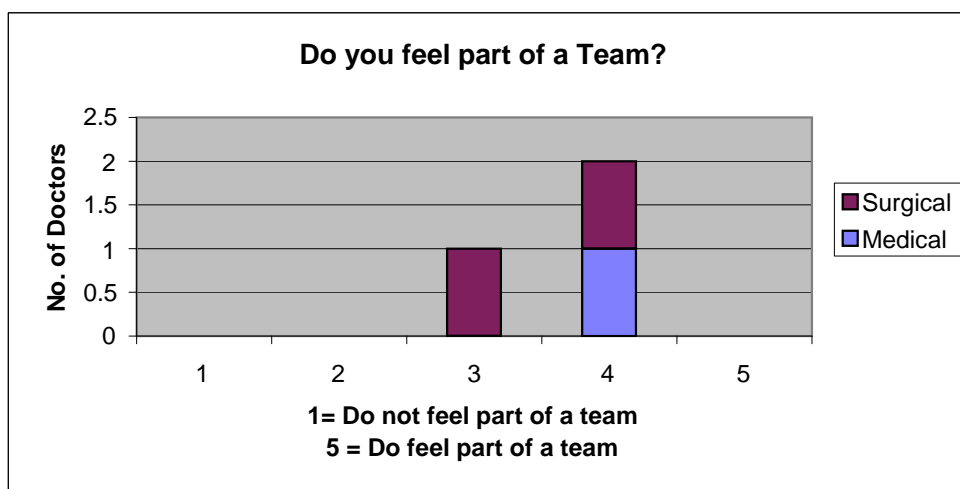

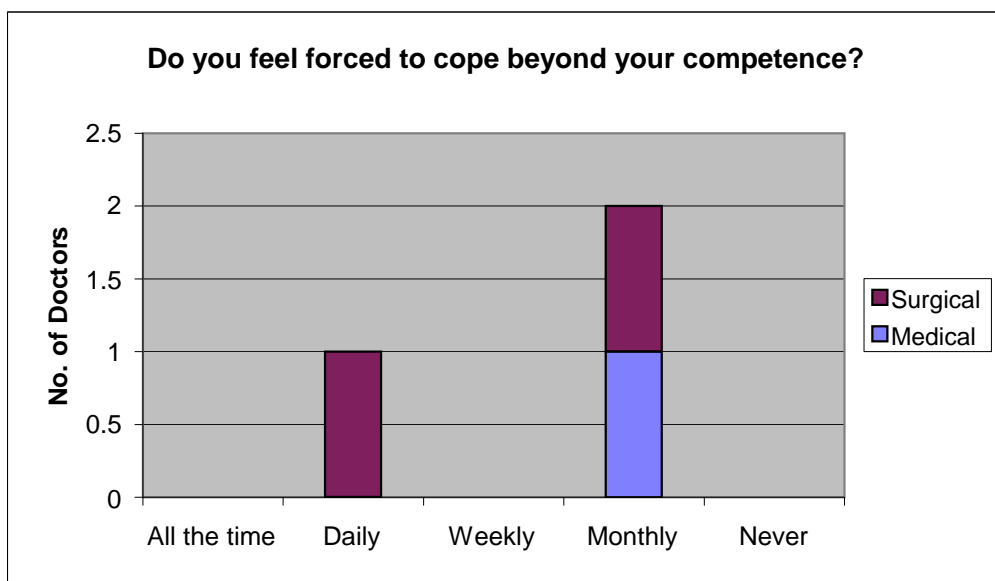
Type of F1 post at present Medical Surgical

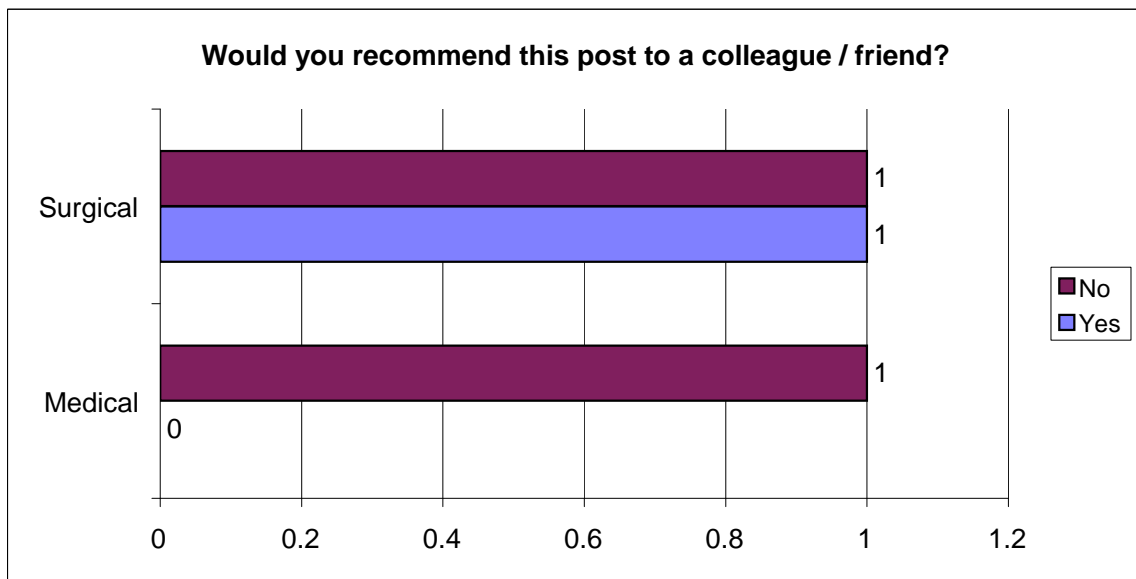

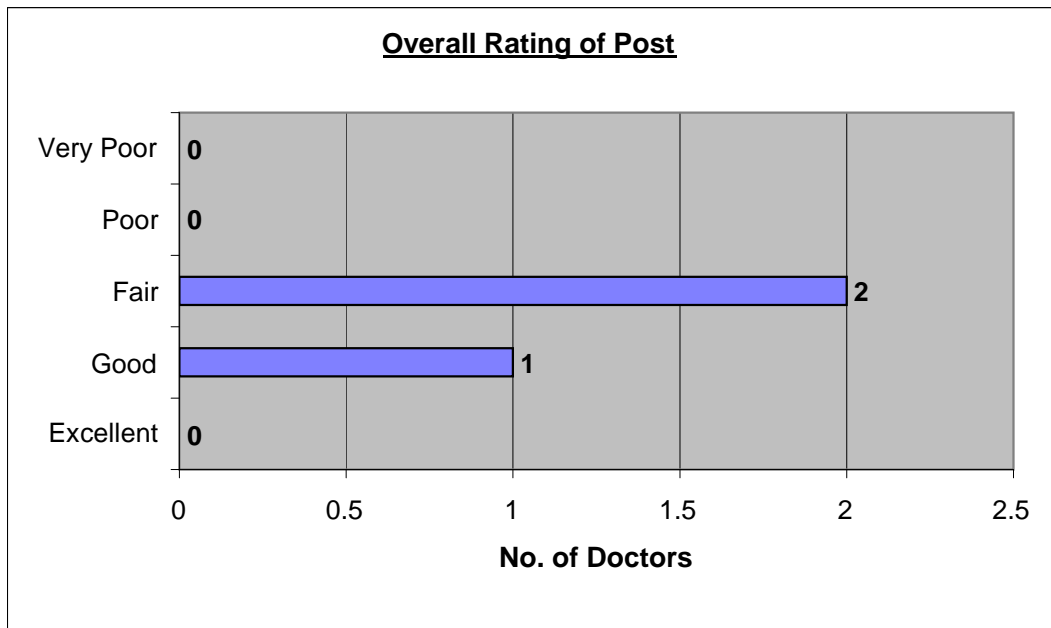
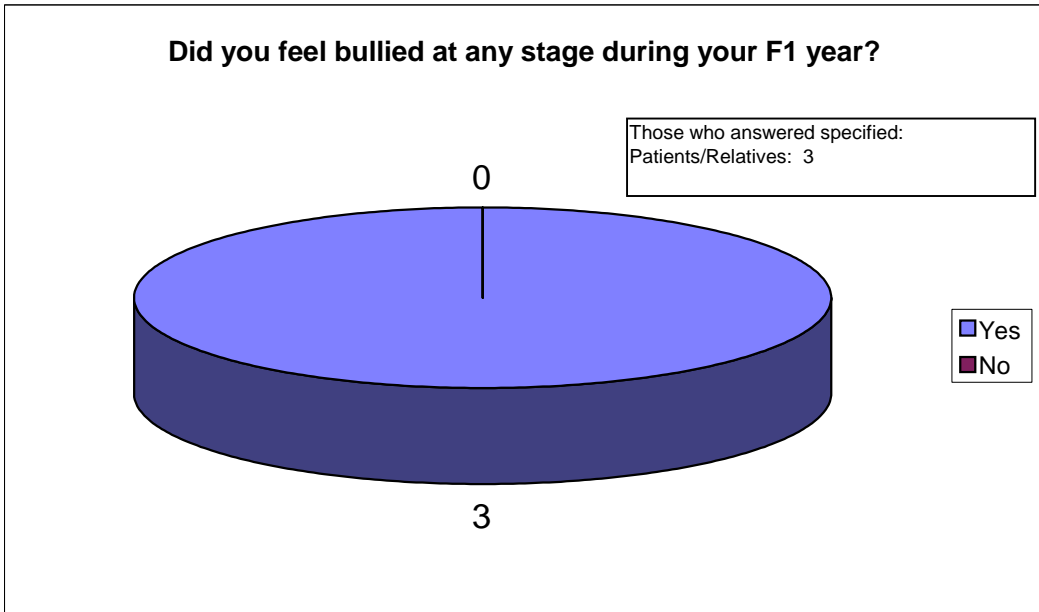

COMMENTS:

Phlebotomists on every ward would be beneficial

More clinical exposure to acute admissions. Teaching time should be protected and more organised

There is no provision for security in hospital out of hours. No night security - one episode of tyres in car park being slashed by knife - culprit found on hospital property. Nurses refuse to help to assist junior doctors in administering IV/IM sedatives/antipsychotics in acutely psychotic patients. Junior doctors are expected to do the same by themselves despite nursing staff being informed by clinical services manager that they can and should assist in the same circumstances.
