In summary

Those roles where appraisee has a different employer or manager should have a form CP2a in a role, outside of GMS, where a GP is being paid should have an ICP if no CP2a is available. In some of the above cases where it is stated that an ICP is required, there might be an employer/manager who can provide a form CP2a instead, which is obviously the preferred option.
