After successful completion of the Learning and Teaching course, applications for becoming a GP Trainer should be made by June for approval as a GP Trainer by August

Eligibility criteria for new GP Trainers:

- Passed L&T within the specified timeframe (see 'Becoming a GP Trainer' booklet for further info)
- On PMPL for at least 2 years to be a GP Trainer
- On PMPL for at least 1 year post certification to begin L&T
- Not have any current undertakings or conditions applied by the GMC or HSCB
- Be a Partner or salaried doctor in a practice
- Work at least 4 sessions if based in a current training practice with another GP Trainer, or 5 or more sessions if based in a new training practice
- Must be 1 year post CCT prior to commencing the course
- Have adequate capacity within the practice for training

Please note that demand for GP Trainers may vary across the region
