

GP (ST3) ACADEMIC RESEARCH TRAINING SCHEME (GPARTS) PERSON SPECIFICATION

There are three GP (ST3) Academic Research Trainee Scheme (GPARTS) posts available. The duration of the post will be 2 years from the start date of the ST3 training post.

Essential Criteria

1. Hold full registration with the General Medical Council.
2. At time of application Trainees must be a GP Trainee in Northern Ireland and be able to demonstrate suitable and appropriate progression in training for example, a satisfactory outcome at their most recent ARCP. Trainees should also be in a position to commence the GPARTS Post as a GP ST3 between 1st Feb 2024 and 31st January 2025.
3. Develop a topic of interest relevant to General Practice / Primary Care which could be discussed at interview as an area for research.
4. At commencement of the post applicants should have successfully completed ST2 year of the GP Specialty Training Programme.
5. Have experience of conducting/contributing to a research/audit/Quality Improvement project.
6. Hold a current full UK Driving License or access to a form of personal transport at time of appointment.
7. Have experience of delivering presentations.
8. Have computer literacy skills.

Desirable Criteria

1. Have experience in using presentation software packages, word processing and statistical software packages.
2. Have been awarded prizes for relevant research.
3. Have had research published in peer reviewed journals.
4. Have published medical articles in non-peer reviewed journals.
5. Have presented at local/national/international conferences.
