## GMC Registration

- Any new F1s who have not yet applied for GMC Provisional Registration, please do so as soon as possible, stating 24th July 2023 as the start date. Provisional Registration is required for new F1s when they begin working in a hospital – if you have applied with a different start date, that is also fine, as long as it covers you from the date you commence your post. ## Revalidation for new consultants

The 4 Nation Trainee Revalidation Oversight Group has been working with GMC around supporting doctors who move into Consultant or Locally Employed posts during or after training. This has focussed on reminding this group of the ongoing appraisal and revalidation requirements once they are out of the ARCP / Form R / SOAR process.

## SCRIPT Safe Prescribing & E-learning

All incoming F1 trainees will soon be registered for the SCRIPT online resource. This is a valuable asset designed to support trainees via a range of interactive methods.

Time spent using SCRIPT can be recorded on TURAS and can be counted towards overall teaching time. Please note that trainees are required to log 60 hours of teaching on TURAS. E-Learning is counted as non-core compared to the core "face-to-face" teaching.

All current F1 trainees moving onto F2 will retain access to SCRIPT until completion of your F2 year.
